The season of Lent begins in February. Although as Baptists we do not observe Lent, I believe as a Christian we can gain much by reflecting on Jesus Christ during this time.

February 10th is Ash Wednesday, which starts Lent. Ash Wednesday is a day to ponder our relationship with God and with one another. Also to reflect on the cross and empty tomb.

There are five weeks leading up to Holy week which includes Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and then the blessed day of Easter Sunday.

On Sunday February 7th you will receive a devotion booklet titled "Living the Gospel Life." If you're willing, take a few moments each day over the next few weeks leading up to Easter to reflect on your relationship with Jesus Christ our Savior. Following are some extra scriptures to reflect on, if you so desire.

Ash Wednesday: Luke 5:27-32. (Ponder)

Week 1 : Luke 19 : 1-10 . (Purpose)

Week 2: John 10: 14 - 18 (People)

Week 3:1 Peter 2:9-10 (Proclaim)

Week 4: Psalm 34:1-10 (Praise)

Week 5: Luke 15:11-32 & 23:26-49 (Pain)

Palm Sunday: Luke 19: 28 -30.

Maundy Thursday : Luke 22 : 14 - 23 & 39 - 46 .

Good Friday: Luke 23.

Easter Sunday: Luke 24:1-12.

I encourage each of us to take some time to read Gods word during this season. To reflect on purpose of the cross and the purpose of our lives in Jesus Christ. may the Holy Spirit speak to us and guide us as individuals and as a Church.

The new Bibles will be about \$12 each, and 32 Bibles are needed.




