Pastor's Pen - May 2016

During my daily devotion from April 25, 2016, I was intrigued with the passage of John 9:39. Just one verse! Jesus said, "I came into this world for judgment so that those who do not see may see and those who do see may become blind."

What is Jesus saying? I thought Jesus came to save the world not to condemn the world. I think what Jesus is trying to tell us is that whenever a person is confronted with Jesus, that a person passes judgment on them self. If a person sees in Jesus nothing to desire, nothing to admire, nothing to love, then that person has condemned their self. If a person sees Jesus as something to wonder over, something to respond to, something to reach out to, then that person is on their way to God.

The one who has all the knowledge of God and still does not recognize the good of God condemns one's self. Their condemnation lays in the fact that they claim to see God so well, but yet fail to recognize the son of God (Jesus).

Below is the devotion I mentioned above. I pray and hope you find some insight as I have.

One day, I accompanied my friend to an eye appointment. While there I was asked if I wanted to undergo the same eye examination as my friend. I said that I didn't think I needed glasses. I felt I could see well enough. However, I decided to go ahead with the examination, more out of curiosity then a sense of need. After the exam, the ophthalmologist explained that my vision was not good and I should have begun using glasses years ago. The doctor further explained that when people come in for appointments, they are often convinced their vision is fine because they have no point of reference. They are not aware of their poor vision until they look through the graduated lenses and notice the difference.

After this experience, I reflected on our relationship with God. We believe that our relationship is fine - that is, until we have an experience of God's joy, peace, assurance and loving presence that deepens our relationship. We view things through a different lens and gain a new perspective - one that brings us into a closer intimacy with God.

Old Business - Gretchen has little rocks for the "1st Stone" - Nadine has bigger ones, about 30. Will start working on these at the next meeting.


