Psalm 4:6-7

Many are asking, "Who can show us any good?" Let the light of your face shine upon us, O Lord. You have filled my heart with greater joy than when their grain and new wine abound. NIV

How true that is of our situation today. Many are asking. "Who can show us any good?" True joy that excels anything that we can get from mere material prosperity or security or satisfaction. So remember, it's the light of God's countenance that will make your life meaningful and secure.

Devotions - Roger opened with prayer, and read the Secret Place devotion for today.

Clerks Report: Minutes from March meeting were in bulletin and in April Messenger

Treasurers Report: Reports distributed, Audit report received from Estep Accounting - no problems. Pastor met with Shannon from Marshall Community Foundation - they have a Ken Combs Memorial Fund. MCC will contact Jean Combs to see what she would like to do with the funds.

Property Management Ministry Team: Rick Frey: Windows going into sanctuary -have them etched for \$295; New doors - Roger's Glass - current doors are not up to code. Replaced ones have to be at least 31" wide. Make 1 36" and the stationery one 24"? Est. \$3,000 to do new doors; Windows in sanctuary - just solid windows, not ones that can be opened. \$5,100 quote; Rick is meeting with the Entryway Task Force tomorrow; Motion by Mary Ivey that we approve \$8,500 for the doors, windows, decals, with funds from the Souder Fund as needed. If more funds are needed, they will come from the same fund. Second by Dawn Frey. Motion passed; Chairs for the round tables in old fellowship hall - black padded chairs at Sam's Club, \$20 each. Motion by Joy Sommers to purchase 24 chairs from Sam's Club, second by Mary Ivey. Motion passed. Will ask about using some of the memorial funds.

Deacon Ministry Team: Sunday, June 18th at 2 pm Funeral for Joyce Clem. Pastor Schlee is officiating; Prayer Chain - emails/calls - all deacons to have access to be able to send the emails and/or make the calls; Food loss from freezer - food is being replaced. Roger will stabilize the freezer shelves better; Vacancy on Deacon Ministry Team - Ed Kirkland; Next meeting is June 7th.

Worship Ministry Team: Kathy is selecting hymns for June; Sing happy birthday second Sunday of each month; June 11th - Graduation Sunday, Dorothy Witmyer giving testimony; June 18th - Father's Day - Heather to give tribute, Joy ask Glennie to make cookies; Flowers in sanctuary can be real or artificial. Those with allergies will watch schedule; During July/August, we will be doing 'pick-a-hymn'; July 2nd Service, we will do pledges to American & Christian flags and the Bible; . Next meeting is scheduled for July 12th.

Educational Ministry Team: Easter Youth Day went very well; Need substitute teachers for Sunday school classes; Jacob will be leaving for college, so we will need a new teacher for the 6-8th grade class; Children's Time - schedule to be revamped.

Boy Scouts: Need to remind them that they need to make sure doors are locked properly.

Other: Northern Seminary Campus is being sold; July 11-18, pastor on vacation. Internet service at church? Pastor contacted Comcast for a quote, \$80/month. Pastor will also check with AT&T. Motion by Mary Ivey, second by Rick Frey for Pastor/Joy to investigate & secure the best option for internet services at the church. Motion approved. Chromebook for Pastor - using this now instead of laptop. Motion by Joy Sommers, second by Mary Ivey to pay \$159.99 for the Chromebook from the A/V Fund. Computer upstairs (projection) - may replace with pastor's old laptop. Church Breakfasts - revisit at September meeting.

As the waters cover the sea.


We ask all this in the wonderful name of Jesus, Who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit.
