- o Load groceries

Week 2 (2/12/23): LOVE IS THE SECRET SAUCE - John 13:34-35

- Make an effort to affirm someone outside of the church
- Hand out a card with words of encouragement or scripture on them

Week 3 (2/19/23): LOVING THE BLENDED FAMILY - 1 Peter 4:8

- Call or send cards to people in your family expressing how much you love them and/or to someone on the CBC prayer list

Week 4 (2/26/23): THE POWER OF LOVE - 1 Corinthians 13:1-8

- Contribute to a valentine box for each CBC family. Put in a note or card, or whatever you would like to give that family

Challenge for the first week of February - We have red paper hearts available. Each person is asked to take a heart, write their intentional act(s) of kindness...or misses on the heart. Bring the heart back next Sunday, put it in the collection plate and take a new heart for the second week focus. Then during the week, the Worship Ministry Team will tape them to the inside of the front doors for the world to see (can be anonymous). Hopefully by the end of the month, the front doors will be full of hearts. You can write multiple acts on one heart or take more than one heart.


