2023 ABC-USA BIENNIAL MISSION SUMMIT

It was a privilege and honor to represent American Baptist Churches of Michigan and Ceresco Baptist Church at the 2023 Biennial Mission Summit in Puerto Rico. It was an opportunity to fellowship with over 1200 fellow American Baptists from all around the United States. We coalesced around our challenges which include in a decline in the number of full-time clergy, mission giving and church attendance, as well as polarization and apathy in the denomination. We asked ourselves, "what is the role of American Baptists in the US mental health crisis; world hunger; women in ministry; the wars in Syria and Ukraine; social justice; gun violence; pay disparities, human trafficking and so much more. There is a growing sense that people are perishing.

We also came together in hope as we reimagined Christ's mission and considered what it means for us to love one another and how we express that love. We found hope in the fact seven in 10 (71%) say their view of Jesus is positive. Of all U.S. teens and adults, 63 percent say they have made a personal commitment to Jesus Christ that is still important in their life today. Seventy percent of Millennials say their commitment to Jesus is still important to them. That is encouragement enough to continue the mission. In the coming days, we should receive an overview of ABC-USA's commitment and priorities for us to consider.

Below is a short overview of a few of the sessions attended:

The National Black Caucus' position is that public policy advocacy is a spiritual discipline and is a form of praying. Praying is a first step but the second step is moving our feet. We should pray for a robust theological imagination that helps us to chart the path going forward.

The MMBB Member Luncheon and Address spoke to current challenges of the faith such as ongoing church decline, polarization, and apathy. There was a call to embrace our ability to dream and love one another. In addition there was an acknowledgment that we have hope when we have love, compassion, openness to change, children, inclusion, and diversity.

Intergenerational Connection for Such a Time means working together and not just adding a youth ministry or a senior ministry. It is creating an opportunity for groups to come together in all aspects. It is not telling youth how they fit into the worship but asking them.

Mission Summit Conversations centered the potential mission focus of ABC USA for the next 2 years. While there were more than 20 entries, the following are the top 7 priority areas:

Empowering Young Adults and Youth

Peacemaking in a Culture of Violence

Mental Health

Creation Care

Building the Beloved Community through Collaboration

Discipleship and Disciple Making

Claim, Distinguish, and Proclaim the Markers of American Baptists

First Things First: Soul Care and Self Care

Pausing to consider how your action and inaction reflects God.

Awareness and reaction to sin.

Asking God to enable us to repent and to forgive.

Soul Care is: (continued)

Holy Spirit inspired awareness of good and bad triggers. Knowing habits and patterns that limit or prevent self-care. Surrendering motivations to the Holy Spirit. Inviting God to change us and meaning it.

Self-Care is:

Regular physical checkups
Accountability partners
Eating well and paying attention to what your body needs
Mental check in and check ups
Pausing to rest and reflect and check in with yourself
Daily affirmations
Pausing to rest
Respecting boundaries
Checking your motivation

of our age yield to a true time of peace, when men and nations shall share a life that honors the dignity of each, the brotherhood of all.




